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## **Tournament Rules**

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1. Entrants **MUST** be members of an American Legion Post, Auxiliary, or Sons of the American Legion of the Department of Illinois.
  - A. SAL members who are 18 years or older and not participating in school sports or Y. A. B. A. bowling program.
  - B. Auxiliary members who are 18 years or older and not participating in school sports are Y. A. B. A. bowling program.
2. Events will consist of four-person teams, two-person teams and individuals, men or women. Bowlers participating in all three events are eligible to compete in the all events. All prize money is based on handicap scores.
3. The averages given shall be the Bowlers highest league average of last year (as of 21 or more games). In either sanctioned or non sanctioned league's Bowlers with no previous average must bowl 12 or more games to determine average for current season as of October 17, 2009. Bowlers who participated in the 2007 tournament who have no established average set forth above shall enter it in the average column on entry blank the letters "TA" and an average will be established from last year's records based on not less than 9 games bowled. Bowlers without either such established average shall be given a tournament average of 160 for men, and 140 for women.
  - A. If current season's average based on 12 games or more is 10 pins higher than the previous year's average, the current average will prevail (Provisions of USBC Rule 319A-2). No previous prize winnings need be reported.
4. Handicap for all Bowlers shall be 100% of the difference between the reported average and 200 with no handicap pin limit.
5. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score or if submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher.
6. A bowler may participate more than once in the team event but is limited to participation only once in the doubles and singles. When more than three players bowl together more than once, the teams with which they compete are eligible for only one position standing prize. Contestant's first score in any event shall count toward his or her "all events" total.
7. Individuals not sanctioned by USBC may pay a participation fee of \$5.00 Rule 301B2.
8. Trophies will be awarded to handicap winners in each event.
9. Average Adjustment Requirements of USBC Rule 319E shall apply to all entrants.
10. No PBA members will be allowed to bowl in this tournament.
11. In cases not covered by above rules, Rules and Regulations of USBC shall govern and the decision of the Tournament Director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
12. All Team Captains must meet with the Tournament Director 30 minutes prior to scheduled bowling time.
