The GIFTS TO THE YANKS program has had the continuous support and cooperation of our American Legion Posts and Auxiliary Units, the S.A.L., 40/8, 8/40 as well as receiving private contributions from individuals, businesses and other veteran organizations.

The last sentence of our Legion Preamble asks us to ***“consecrate and sanctify our Comradeship by our devotion to mutual helpfulness”*** and part of the opening prayer at our meetings includes ***“we ask thy blessing and comfort for those Comrades who are suffering mental and physical disability. SUGGESTED METHODS OF RAISING FUNDS:

1. Direct contributions from Post or Units
