Our five day, 500+ mile journey is up like this so far:

Day 1 (Tuesday): Starting in Springfield and riding thru Beardstown, Mount Sterling and into Quincy.

Day 2 (Wednesday): Quincy, thru Macomb, Monmouth, and into Galesburg.

Day 3 (Thursday): Galesburg, thru Rock Island, and into Rock Falls.

Day 4 (Friday): Rock Falls, thru Freeport, Rockford, and into Woodstock.

Day 5 (Saturday): Woodstock, thru West Dundee, Arlington Heights, Fort Sheridan, and finally finishing at Great Lakes Naval Station.

We will start the detailed route coordination in a couple months, after we've gotten a little rest and bodies healed!
