- Veggies (broccoli, cauliflower, bell peppers (variety), cherry tomatoes, radishes, baby carrots, celery)

For monetary donations: Money donations are used for renting the tent (\$900 alone),

Make checks payable to <u>American Legion Dept. of IL</u> so Department can cash it, then earmark in the memo section "<u>Special Olympics</u>" so C&Y gets the donation.

Notify your C&Y Division Chairmen of donations, so we will have an idea of supplies and money. Send or take donations to Department HQ by the first week in June.
