
#### **LINCOLN PILGRIMAGE AWARD**

In the 2026 card year, we will continue to promote the 5-year card program. To qualify for this incentive, a Post must have a current Certification of Officers form and a Consolidated Post Report on file. Your post must also be above the threshold to be a Post in good standing (above 15).

#### **5 YEAR GOLD CARD PLAN**

Spread the word to your members regarding the 5 Year Gold Card. This will not only benefit the member, but the post as well. Here are some of the benefits:

- It's money the Posts can invest
- It's cheaper than a Paid Up for Life membership
- It's a convenience for the Post and the member. Department will update all 5 year members at the start of a new card year, which means the posts do not have to collect money on those members. The member then does not have to worry about sending in dues.
- Each 5 year member will receive a "5 Year Gold" card with their name, post number, card & ID number and the years in which they're covered by the plan.
- The cost of a 5 year card is \$200.00. The Post would collect 5 years of post dues and then would submit \$200.00 per capita ( $$40.00 \times 5 = $200.00$ )
